Meeting with Owyhee County Sheriff's Office, Motioned by Councilman Herman to pay the month of Oct 2020, and be on the Agenda for October Council meeting. 2nd Councilman Even. All agree Motion passed. Mayor is to talk to the school board regarding School Resource Officer funds. Per Sheriff Grant, the original contract was for School resource officer and to help with ordinances, not to patrol in City. If the city wanted to go in for a full time Deputy through OCSO, it would be somewhere around \$90,000.00 a year, but they would need to run numbers (40 HRS a week, car, uniform, and training.) if we chose not to go with a contract OCSO would still answer 911 calls, just not ordinance calls. City Clerk Jolyn Green was directed to find cost and details of starting a new department.

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


- Auction details for 425 W. Main St. Motion to table until we get appraisal, Councilman Even 2nd Councilman R. Percifield all agree motion passed.
