


**MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF MARSING

SPECIAL MEETING – BUDGET WORKSHOP**

1. Mayor Corder called the meeting to order at 10:00 am and took roll call - Councilman Even, Councilman Herman, Councilman Wahl, Councilman Johnson, Attorney Stephanie Bonney, City Clerk Jolyn Thompson and Deputy Clerk Kim Even, Administrative Asst., Debbie Carter, interim PW Superintendent Philip Gibson, Ordinance Seth Wahl, and PW Stephen Rydell were all in attendance.
2. Hiring Public Works employee – Possible Action Item
 - a. Job Description and Help Wanted Ad – Use Indeed again – Directed to put appointment of Philip Gibson as Superintendent on May 10th agenda, chose to address the hiring during the budget workshop
3. Budget Workshop – Council went through and set the draft budget for 2023, as well as:
 - a. Directed City Clerk to place appointment of Philip Gibson as Public Works Superintendent on the May 10th agenda, moved Seth Wahl to full time Public Works, and raised wages for both Public Works employees, Stephen Rydell and Seth Wahl.
 - b. Directed staff to set advertisements for a fourth full time Public Works employee and a part-time Code Enforcement officer. Seth Wahl will continue to cover code enforcement issues as needed and will train the new employee.
 - c. Allocated \$150,000 ARPA funds to a permanent structure on South Island Park
 - d. Allocated \$50,000 ARPA funds to developing the dog park on North Island Park
 - e. Allocated \$5,000 ARPA funds to public relations for website training, Senior Citizen activities, and free movie night.
4. Motion to Adjourn – Councilman Marie Herman motioned to adjourn, Councilman Elizabeth Wahl seconded, all were in favor, motion passed at 1:39 pm
